TRUCK 1 RESPONDED TO AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL CALL ON OAK ST. PRESENTED WITH A FEMALE PATIENT WHO WAS UNCONSCIOUS AND BLUE AROUND THE LIPS. PATIENT WAS AGONAL BREATHING, BUT HAD NO DETECTABLE PULSE. MFD WAS FIRST ON THE SCENE AND INITIATED CPR. MEDIC 1 ARRIVED JUST AFTER MFD AND APPLIED THE AED. MFD CONTINUED CPR WHILE MHEMS#1 PUSHED DRUGS AND SHOCKED PATIENT. EMS RESTORED A PULSE BEFORE THE PATIENT WAS TRANSPORTED TO MORRISTOWN-HAMBLLEN HOSPITAL. WITNESS SAID SHE HAD SPOKEN TO PATIENT APPROXIMATELY 30 MINUTES EARLIER. PATIENT HAD A HISTORY OF SURGERY TO REMOVE PART OF HER STOMACH. HER GALLBLADDER HAD ALSO BEEN REMOVED. MFD GATHERED INFORMATION AND RETURNED TO SERVICE. CPT. MOSHIER, ENG. LEPHEW.
