The patient, an MFD employee, was using the station treadmill. He made a call directly into the station, and stated that he thought he may be having a heart attack. MFD personnel found the patient sitting in a slumped position at the treadmill. During the patient assessment, he stated that he could not breathe. An ambulance was dispatched. Limited vitals were recorded using a SPO2 monitor. O2 @ 98%, and a pulse rate of 132. The same vitals were monitored until the ambulance arrived; O2 @ 97%, and pulse 136, and a final reading of O2 @ 96%, and a pulse rate of 225. The patient became unresponsive upon arrival of Medic 5, and Medic 5 personnel began CPR. MFD personnel packaged, and loaded the patient, and assisted EMS to the hospital. Signed: LT Timothy D.
