The City of Morristown will solicit comments on its 2022 Consolidated Annual Performance & Evaluation Report at a Public Hearing held at **10:00A.M. on Wednesday, September 20, 2023** at the following location: **City of Morristown City Hall, Training Room, 100 W First North Street, Morristown, TN 37814**. This Notice will commence the City's 15-day public comment period beginning on **Monday, September 11, 2023** and ending on **Wednesday, September 27, 2023**.

The City is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to annually submit a Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER). This report provides an assessment of the City's progress in carrying out its five-year strategic plan and its one-year action plan for the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). The purpose of this notice is to make the CAPER report available to the public for comments prior to its submittal to HUD.

Draft copies of the 2022 Consolidated Annual Performance & Evaluation Report will be available for examination and comment by the public during the public hearing scheduled **Wednesday, September 20, 2023 at 10:00A.M.** The required public review ends **Wednesday, September 27, 2023**. The City will receive written comments until 5:00 P.M. on **Wednesday, September 27, 2023**.
