About the Legacy Tree

Program

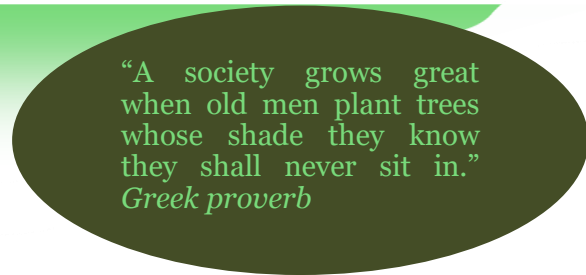
Trees are a great asset to our community and are not only beautiful, but offer many environmental benefits as well. A healthy tree that can be enjoyed for many generations is a wonderful way to honor a special person.

In an effort to increase trees throughout the city, the Tree Board, in partnership with Keep Morristown-Hamblen Beautiful, established the Legacy Tree program in 2005. Loved ones may be remembered or honored through a donation that is used for the planting of new trees. The trees may be located in our city's public places such as parks, parking islands or along the greenway. A donor may select the tree type and location under the guidance of the Board. A marker is installed at the tree with the name of the tree (common and scientific), the name of the person being honored and the donor.



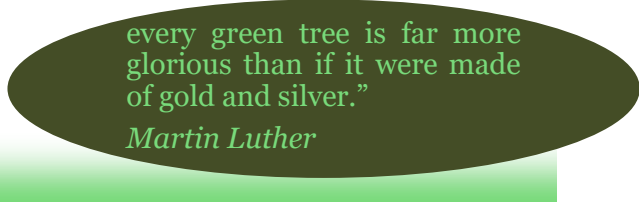
The cost of donating a tree through the Legacy Tree Program is **\$200** (tax deductible). The price includes the cost of the largest, healthiest tree we can find, transportation, planting, and fabrication/ installation of a dedicatory plaque.

Trees are planted in the next appropriate planting season, typically late fall or early spring, as opposed to immediately upon receipt of a donation. This is to give the trees the best possible start. Donors are encouraged to help look after their special trees by alerting the Tree Board if they have concerns about the condition of the tree.



Finding A Tree After It Is Planted

Once a Legacy Tree has been planted, it will be added to the Legacy Tree App on the Morristown Tree Board's webpage. The app features maps of parks and the greenway where Legacy Trees have been planted. Each tree is assigned a number as shown in the example below and includes information about the tree.



Tree Species

The following tree species, listed by common name, have been selected for planting through the Legacy Tree program:

- American Holly
- Arborvitae 'green giant'
- Bald Cypress
- Cherry (Kwanzan or Yoshino)
- Gingko (non- fruiting)



- Gum (Black or Sweet)
- Japanese Cryptomeria
- Linden
- Dogwood
- Foster Holly
- Magnolia 'little gem'
- Maple (Red or sugar)
- Oak (many varieties)
- Redbud



- Sycamore
- Tulip Poplar
- River Birch
- White Pine
