

STREET NAMES

All proposed names for public street and private easements shall be reviewed and approved by the Morristown Regional Planning Commission (MRPC).

- No duplicate street names are allowed.
- New street names shall be unique:
 - ◊ no reference street type suffixes (road, drive, lane, etc.)
 - ◊ no directional words (north, south, east, west)
 - ◊ no combining two words or separating one word.
- Street names cannot exceed twenty (20) characters.
- Common suffixes that may be used for a cul-de-sac are Lane, Court, Way, and Place.

WHAT IS AN E911 ADDRESS?

An E911 address assist emergency services in responding to emergency calls quickly. E 911 location addresses are also often required for telephone service, building permits, driver's license renewal, mail and package delivery, insurance and more.

ENSURE YOUR TELEPHONE SERVICE PROVIDER HAS YOUR CORRECT E 911 ADDRESS

Children, visitors, hearing or speech impaired callers, or callers in a life-threatening situation, may not be able to provide address information to dispatchers. Be sure your telephone provider has your correct E 911 address as it is the information displayed at the call center. This allows the dispatchers to send the appropriate fire, medical personnel, or law enforcement.

NEW PUBLIC & PRIVATE STREETS

If a driveway provides access to 3 or more dwellings, the driveway will be identified as a private street. The naming of a street does not imply ownership or maintenance responsibility by the Municipality.

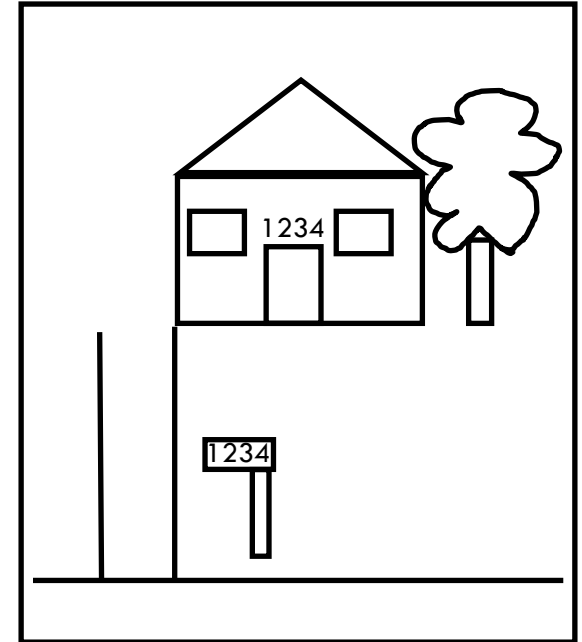
ASSIGNING A NEW OR CORRECTING AN ADDRESS

The Morristown-Hamblen GIS (MHGIS) staff assign and change all addresses in Hamblen County. Addresses are assigned based on the Uniform Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance. All property in Hamblen County must have a valid E 911 street address to receive a development permit. This applies to both individuals and contractors. Request a new or correct an existing address from MHGIS located in the Planning Department at the City Center.

MHGIS coordinates with 911, USPS, and other local government agencies to correct addressing problems. Valid addresses consist of a number and a road name. Common problems include addresses shared by more than one structure, duplicate road names or address numbers, non-sequential address numbers, continuous road segments with the same name but different road type.

Addresses for each lot and/or building are derived using the street that allows main access to the primary structure and will be in sequence with surrounding addresses. Address and suite numbers will be whole numbers.

ADDRESS SIGNAGE



- The house number should be placed within five (5) feet of the front door, provided that the front door is clearly visible from the street in front of the building. Buildings with access to an alley shall post the house number on the rear of the building. Numbers should be at least 3 1/2 inches in height and made of reflective material.
- The house number should be on the mailbox.
