The Beer Board for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place in the Morristown City Center at 5:40 p.m., Tuesday, January 5, 2016, with the Honorable Mayor Gary Chesney, presiding and the following Beer Board members present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Ken Smith, and Tommy Pedigo.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the December 15, 2015 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Smith seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion to approve the off-premise beer permit Wal-Mart Stores East LP, (Manager and Registered Agent Richard Gregory Holt) Wal-Mart Stores #5467, DBA Wal-Mart Neighborhood Market, 1997 Buffalo Trail. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Beer Board sanctions were considered against the seven following on-premise establishments: Sale of beer to a person under twenty-one years of age (8:213-214)

1. The VFW, 2503 East Andrew Johnson Highway (First Violation).

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion for a thirty (30) day suspension of the beer license or in-lieu thereof of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

2. Ruby Tuesdays, 483 S. Davy Crockett Highway (First Violation).

Councilmember Senter made a motion for a thirty (30) day suspension of the beer license or in-lieu thereof of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

3. The Country Club, 1635 Doyal Drive (First Violation).

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion for a thirty (30) day suspension of the beer license or in-lieu thereof of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

4. El Toro Mexican Restaurant, 2550 East Morris Boulevard (Second Violation).

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion for a thirty (30) day suspension of the beer license or in-lieu thereof of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,250. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

5. Hillside Grill, 3614 West Andrew Johnson Highway (First Violation).

Councilmember Bivens made a motion for a thirty (30) day suspension of the beer license or in-lieu thereof of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

6. Little Dutch Restaurant, 115 South Cumberland Street (Second Violation).

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion for a twenty two (22) day suspension of the beer license or in-lieu thereof of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,250. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".


7. Sagebrush Steak House, 2323 East Morris Boulevard (Third Violation).

Councilmember Bivens made a motion for a twenty (20) day suspension of the beer license or in-lieu thereof of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,500. Motion died for

lack of second.

Councilmember Pedigo made a motion for a thirty (30) day suspension of the beer license or in-lieu thereof of a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,250. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; Councilmembers Garrett, Senter, Smith, Pedigo and Mayor Chesney voted "aye"; Councilmembers Bivens and Alvis voted "no".

Mayor Chesney adjourned the January 5, 2016 meeting of the City of Morristown, Beer Board at 6:40 p.m.
