
The Beer Board for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in session at the regular meeting place in the Morristown City Center at 5:10 p.m., Tuesday, December 19, 2017, with the Honorable Mayor Gary Chesney, presiding and the following Beer Board members present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Ken Smith and Tommy Pedigo.

Beer Board member Smith made a motion to approve the November 21, 2017, minutes as circulated. Beer Board member Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

City Attorney Lauren Carroll advised the Beer Board of the following: In the minutes from the November 21, 2017, Beer Board Meeting one of the entities that came before you for a beer violation was Chuck's Package Store; a liquor package store. As you recall, in 2014 the state passed a law allowing wine to be sold in grocery stores and at that time the state also allowed liquor stores to begin selling beer and rather than making these stores come to the cities to obtain beer permits the State of Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission regulates the sale of beer in liquor stores. The violation issued to Chuck's Package Store was an oversight on our part and the civil penalty imposed should be considered null and void. The clarification is reflected in todays minutes and does not require any additional action by the board.

Beer Board member Pedigo made a motion to approve the off-premise beer permit for Walgreen Boots Alliance, Inc., (Manager and Registered Agent Patricia Damron) DBA Rite Aid #3576, located at 922 South Cumberland Avenue, Morristown, TN. Beer Board member Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Chesney adjourned the December 19, 2017, meeting of the City of Morristown, Beer Board at 5:14 p.m.
