BEER BOARD – April 19, 2022**

The Beer Board for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in session at the regular meeting place of the Beer Board in the Morristown City Center at 6:06 p.m., Tuesday, April 19, 2022 with the Honorable Mayor Gary Chesney presiding and the following Beer Board members present: Al A'Hearn, Chris Bivens, Bob Garrett, Tommy Pedigo, Kay Senter and Ken Smith.

Mayor Chesney opened the floor for members of the audience to speak subject to the guidelines provided. No one spoke.

Beer Board member Senter made a motion to approve the March 15, 2022, minutes as circulated. Beer Board member A'Hearn seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Beer Board member Bivens made a motion to approve the Special Occasion Permit for the Rose Center and Council for the Arts, Inc. for the Spring Thyme with the Appalachian Renaissance Fair/Community Faire on April 22-24, 2022 located at the Rose Center, 442 West 2nd North St., Morristown, TN. Beer Board member Pedigo seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Beer Board sanctions were considered against the following establishments for Failure to Require Presentation of Valid Photo I.D.

1. Monte Alban, 416 South Cumberland (First Violation)

Beer Board member Pedigo made a motion to sanction a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,500 to be paid within seven (7) days in lieu of a thirty (30) day permit suspension. Beer Board member Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

2. Lee's Food Mart, 3616 West AJ Hwy (First Violation)

Beer Board member Pedigo made a motion to sanction a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,500 to be paid within seven (7) days in lieu of a thirty (30) day permit suspension. Beer Board member Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

3. Trader's Corner, 922 South Cumberland Street – No longer in business and beer permit issued was surrendered at time of closing.

4. By-Lo Market, 3606 East Morris Blvd. – Business has been sold and operating under new ownership. Beer permit at time of violation is no longer valid.


5. Rite Quick Market, 710 Morelock Road (First Violation)

Beer Board member Pedigo made a motion to sanction a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,500 to be paid within seven (7) days in lieu of a thirty (30) day permit suspension. Beer Board member Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".


6. Buffalo Trail Market, 1516 Buffalo Trail (First Violation)
