The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, August 19, 2014, with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gary Chesney.

Jonathon Bewley, Chaplain Morristown Police Department led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the August 15, 2014 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Chesney seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Resolution No. 18-14. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-14**  
**A Resolution Authorizing the City of Morristown, Tennessee, to Participate in the TML Risk Management Pool "Driver Safety" Loss Control Matching Grant Program.**

WHEREAS, the safety and well-being of the employees of the City of Morristown is of the greatest importance; and

WHEREAS, all efforts shall be made to provide a safe and hazard-free workplace for the City of Morristown employees; and

WHEREAS, the TML Risk Management Pool seeks to encourage the establishment of a safe workplace by offering a "Driver Safety" Loss Control Matching Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Morristown now seeks to participate in this important program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MORRISTOWN, TENNESSEE the following:

SECTION I. That the City of Morristown is hereby authorized to submit application for a "Driver Safety" Loss Control Matching Grant through the TML Risk Management Pool.

SECTION II. That the City of Morristown is further authorized to provide a matching sum to serve as a match for any monies provided by this grant.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3505 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for September 2, 2014. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3505**

**An Ordinance to Amend the Morristown Municipal Code, Title 14, (Zoning and Land Use Control), Chapter 2, (Zoning Ordinance) by deleting Chapter 11 (CB) Central Business District, Section 14-1107 (Signs in Conservation Section) in its entirety.**

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the bid/contract to East Tennessee Turf and Landscape in the amount of \$36,300 for Runway 5 Tree Obstruction Removal at the Morristown Regional Airport. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the bid/contract to CDW-Government in the amount of \$39,144 to purchase 14 Mobile Units (MDT's) for the Police Department. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve the Justice Assistant Grant in the amount of \$15,909 to purchase laptop computers for the investigations personnel in the Police Department. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve Change Order #1 (Final) to M.G. Hall, LLC the net decrease of the change order is \$5,416.24 bringing the total contract price from \$210,043 to \$207,626.76 for the Jackson Street Sanitary/Stormwater Replacement project. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve Change Order #2 to Hale Construction the net increase of the change order is \$1,595 bringing the total contract price from \$186,975 to \$188,570 for the Talley Ward Recreation Center Renovations. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Garrett made a motion to re-appoint Charles Hurt to the Municipal Airport Commission for a five (5) year term to expire on August 31, 2019. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Thomas made a motion to appoint Rod Isaacs to the Morristown Utility Commission for a five (5) year term to expire on July 31, 2019. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the City of Morristown, TN Debt Policy. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Cheney made a motion to approve a Quitclaim Deed from the City of Morristown to Millstone Golf Club and a Warranty Deed from Millstone Golf Club to the City of Morristown. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the sale of approximately 30 acres in the Morristown Airport Industrial District to Prospect No. 5706 at the total purchase price of \$1,000 per acre. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

City Administrator Tony Cox advised Council on the following budget appropriate line item transfer(s):

- Transfer of \$50,000 from 110-43150-689 (Street Lighting & Signs Misc. Expenses) to 110-41700-801 (Comm/Econ Affairs-Grants & Other Subsidies).
- Transfer of \$4,000 from 110-43150-689 (Street Lighting & Signs Misc. Expenses) to 110-41660-349 (Legal Services-Attorney Consulting Fees).
