The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 16, 2014, with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gary Chesney.

Mark Burford, Chaplain Morristown Police Department led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the December 2, 2014 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

A Public Hearing was held regarding Ordinance No. 3504.03.

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3504.03 on second and final reading. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3504.03**

**An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance Number 3504, The City of Morristown, Tennessee Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 and Appropriate the Sum of \$20,000 from the Governor Highway Safety Grant to Cover Additional Overtime for Patrol Officers.**

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3511 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for January 6, 2015. Councilmember Chesney seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3511**

**An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee Amending Title 8, Chapter 1 of the Morristown Municipal Code (Intoxicating Liquors/Liquor Stores).**

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3512 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for January 6, 2015. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3512**

**An Ordinance to Amend the Municipal Code of the City of Morristown, Tennessee, Appendix B. [Rezoning of Properties located on the north side of W. Andrew Johnson Highway between Sandstone Drive and Walters Drive (Hamblen County Tax Map Parcels 041B A 00300, 041B A 00203, 0030 C 02500, 041B A 00100 and 0330 C 03900) from Planned Residential Development (RP1), Office Medical & Professional (OMP), Moderate Density Residential (RD2) & Intermediate Business (IB) to Planned Commercial Development (PCD).]**

Councilmember Senter made a motion to the annual support contract with Doe River Technology Services (DRTS) for on-site hardware and software support agreement in the amount of \$2,300 per month for 12 months, billed monthly, with labor cost of \$125 per hour for Networking Service and \$75 per hour for all other services. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve Change Order No. 2 Storm Drainage Improvements – Whitewood Circle/Jaybird Road, MLK, Jr. Park & Cub Circle, to J&H Construction the net increase of this change order \$8,000 and increase of 60 calendar days, bringing total of contract from \$377,415 to \$385,415. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted “aye”.

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between Knoxville-Knox County Community Action Committee and the City of Morristown Extension. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted “aye”.

City Administrator Cox introduced Alan Hartman, Development Director/Planning, who gave a report to Council on the South Cumberland Land Use Plan that has been developed by the Planning Department.

Mayor Thomas adjourned the December 16, 2014 City Council meeting at 5:24 p.m.
