The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, December 2, 2014, with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gary Chesney.

Jonathon Bewley, Chaplain Morristown Police Department led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the November 18, 2014 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

A Public Hearing was held regarding Ordinance No. 3509.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3509 on second and final reading. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

A Public Hearing was held regarding Ordinance No. 3510.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3510 on second and final reading. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3504.03 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for December 16, 2014. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".


**An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance Number 3504, The City of Morristown,
Tennessee Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 and Appropriate the
Sum of \$20,000 from the Governor Highway Safety Grant to Cover
Additional Overtime for Patrol Officers.**

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve a bid/contract for White Double Jacketed Rubber Lined Polyester Hose for the Fire Department from Municipal Emergency Services; 100 sections of 1.75" hose at the cost of \$7,500 and 90 sections of 3.0" hose at the cost of \$13,304.70. These hoses will be purchased by using a portion of the Department of Homeland Security's Assistance to Firefighters Grant; the breakdown will be 90% grant funds in the amount \$18,724.23 and 10% city match in the amount of \$2,080.47. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve a bid/contract for Carbon Composition SCBA Bottles for the Fire Department from Municipal Emergency Services; 40 bottles at a cost of \$27,998. These bottles will be purchased by using a portion of the Department of Homeland Security's Assistance to Firefighters Grant; the breakdown will be 90% grant funds in the amount of \$25,198.20 and 10% city match in the amount of \$2,799.80. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve the City of Morristown Financial Policies. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Thomas adjourned the December 2, 2014 City Council meeting at 5:20 p.m.
