The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, January 6, 2015, with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gary Chesney, absent; Kay Senter.

Mike Cutshaw, Chaplain Morristown Police Department led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the December 16, 2014 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

A Public Hearing was held regarding Ordinance No. 3511.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3511 on second and final reading. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee
Amending Title 8, Chapter 1 of the Morristown Municipal Code
(Intoxicating Liquors/Liquor Stores).**

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3512 on second and final reading. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Morristown, Tennessee, Appendix B. [Rezoning of Properties located on
the north side of W. Andrew Johnson Highway between Sandstone Drive and
Walters Drive (Hamblen County Tax Map Parcels 041B A 00300, 041B A 00203,
0030 C 02500, 041B A 00100 and 0330 C 03900) from Planned Residential
Development (RP1), Office Medical & Professional (OMP), Moderate Density
Residential (RD2) & Intermediate Business (IB) to Planned Commercial
Development (PCD).]**


