The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 20, 2014, with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gary Chesney.

Mark Burford, Senior Chaplain Morristown Police Department Chaplain led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the May 6, 2014 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

A Public Hearing was held regarding Ordinance No. 3476.17.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3476.17 on second and final reading. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3476.17

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance Number 3476, The City of Morristown, Tennessee Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 and Appropriate the Sum of \$1,000 for Project Graduation.

Mayor Thomas made a motion to open the agenda to add a resolution requesting a review of the spending and credit card usage at Morristown Utilities System by the State Comptroller's Office. Motion failed for lack of second.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3500 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for June 3, 2014. Councilmember Chesney seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3501 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for June 3, 2014. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to re-appoint Lonnie Atkins, William Rooney and Tina Dearing to the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board for a three (3) year term to expire June 1, 2017. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".
