The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, November 18, 2014, with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gary Chesney.

Don Lamb, Chaplain Morristown Fire Department led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the November 4, 2014 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Chesney seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3509 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for December 2, 2014. Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3509

**An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee
Amending Title 8 of the Morristown Municipal Code and Adding
Chapter 4 Wine Sales in Retail Food Stores.**

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3510 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for December 2, 2014. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Ordinance No. 3510

**An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee
Amending Title 5 of the Morristown Municipal Code (Municipal
Finance and Taxation).**

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the grant agreement between Tennessee Department of Transportation and the City of Morristown for the Freddie Kyle Park Greenway project. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve the agreement contract with McGill & Associates for Professional Engineering Review Services with a budgeted not to exceed amount of \$40,000. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the TDOT Aeronautics Division Grant Contract to rehabilitate apron pavement and crack seal in the total amount of \$720,000 with a 5% match of \$36,000. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the agreement contract with Revize Software Systems for website design in the amount of \$11,075. Councilmember Chesney seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve Change Order #1 to East TN Turf and Landscape for runway 5 tree obstruction removal, net increase of this change order \$29,030 and increase of 60 calendar days, bringing total of contract from \$36,300 to \$65,330. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve the bid from National Joint Powers Alliance for a Kubota F Series F2690 with a 72" mower deck in the total amount of \$19,643.25 for the Parks & Recreation Department. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the bid from Dorma USA, Inc. for a door and handicap low energy operator in the amount of \$15,815 for the Parks & Recreation Department. Councilmember Chesney seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve a settlement agreement subject to the final approval by Mr. Larry Clark, Administrative Services Director and City Attorney Dick Jessee. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the Police Departments hiring of Dustin Reed as an entry-level Patrol Officer. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to open the agenda. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to give City Employees additional time off during the Christmas Holidays beginning at noon on December 24th and all day on December 26th, in memory of former Councilmember Claude Jinks. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Mayor Thomas adjourned the November 18, 2014 City Council meeting at 5:45 p.m.
