The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, November 4, 2014, with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gary Chesney, absent; Chris Bivens.

Ruth Carpenter, Master Chaplain Morristown Police Department led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the October 21, 2014 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Chesney seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

A Public Hearing was held regarding Ordinance No. 3507.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3507 on second and final reading. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3507
An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee
Amending Title 9, Chapter 15 of the Morristown Municipal Code.**

A Public Hearing was held regarding Ordinance No. 3508. The following people spoke regarding Ordinance No. 3508: Carl Murphy.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3508 on second and final reading. Councilmember Garrett seconded the motion and upon roll call; Councilmembers Garrett, Senter, LeBel and Chesney voted "aye"; Councilmember Alvis and Mayor Thomas voted "no".

**Ordinance No. 3508
An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee
Amending Title 8, Chapter 2 of the Morristown Municipal Code.**

Councilmember Garrett made a motion to approve McGill and Associates for Engineering Review Services based upon staff evaluation of Request for Qualifications (RFP). Councilmember Senter seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve Amendment Number 1 to the Agreement between the Lakeway Area Metropolitan Transportation Planning Organization and Kimley-Horn Associates, Inc. concerning Wayfinding Signage Project. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the TDOT Aeronautics Division Grant Contract to Rehabilitate Apron Pavement and Crack Seal in the total amount of \$720,000 with a 5% match of \$36,000. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the TDOT Aeronautics Division Grant Contract for T-Hangar and Twin Hangar Repair in the total amount of \$386,400 with a 5% City of Morristown match of \$19,320. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the TDOT Aeronautics Division Amended Grant Contract for Obstruction Removal in the total amount of \$24,415 with a 5% City of Morristown match of \$1,221. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".


Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the Work Authorization Number 1 – 2014 Runway 5 Tree Obstruction Removal to include design and construction phase services for additional tree obstruction clearing on Runway 23 end of Morristown Regional Airport to Michael Baker Jr., Inc. in the amount of \$4,800. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve the Police Departments promotion of Michael Hurt to Narcotics Detective Sergeant. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the Police Departments promotion of Jackie Everhart to Narcotics Detective Corporal. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the Police Departments promotion of Jackie Hickey to Narcotics Detective. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".
