The City Council for the City of Morristown, Hamblen County, Tennessee, met in regular session at the regular meeting place of the Council in the Morristown City Center at 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, September 16, 2014, with the Honorable Mayor Danny Thomas, presiding and the following Councilmembers present; Bob Garrett, Chris Bivens, Kay Senter, Dennis Alvis, Paul LeBel and Gary Chesney.

Mike Cutshaw, Chaplain Morristown Police Department led in the invocation and Councilmember Alvis led in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve the September 2, 2014 minutes as circulated. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3504.01 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for October 7, 2014. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3504.01**

**An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance Number 3504, The City of Morristown, Tennessee Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 and Appropriate the Sum of \$2,600 for Office Furniture.**

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 3506 on first reading and schedule a public hearing relative to final passage of said Ordinance for October 7, 2014. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

**Ordinance No. 3506**

**An Ordinance of the City Council of Morristown, Tennessee Amending Title 18, Chapter 2 of the Morristown Municipal Code (Cross Connections, Auxiliary Intakes, Etc.).**

Councilmember Cheney made a motion to approve the Security Fencing Grant Contract from Tennessee Department of Transportation Aeronautics Division in the amount of \$96,500, with a local match of \$4,825. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the bid for 408 Moss Green Roll-Out Garbage Carts to CMI Equipment Sales in the amount of \$29,172. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the bid for 187 Blue Roll-Out Recycle Carts to CMI Equipment Sales in the amount of \$13,744.50. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve the bid for a 2015 Ford F-250 XL from Golden Circle Auto Group for Public Works Dept. in the amount of \$33,424.62. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve the bid for a 2015 Ford F-550 Chassis XL from Golden Circle Auto Group for Public Works Dept. in the amount of \$46,781.16. Councilmember Chesney seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve the Mayor's appointment of Mitchell Trent and re-appointment of Tera Bunch to the Tree Board for three year term(s) to expire on September 18, 2017. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel nominated John Hofer to the Solid Waste Board. Mayor Thomas nominated Doug Deering for re-appointment to the Solid Waste Board. Councilmember LeBel made a motion to close the nominations. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call all voted "aye".

A vote was called for the nomination of John Hofer to the Solid Waste Board; Councilmember Garrett, Bivens, Senter, Alvis, LeBel and Chesney voted "aye"; Mayor Thomas voted "no". Mr. Hofer was appointed to serve a three (3) year term to the Solid Waste Board to expire on October 1, 2017.

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the following selection of the Morristown Backflow and Back-Siphonage Control Board; two representatives of the water department Joseph Wigington and Mike Howard, plumbing inspector Greg Ellison, attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee Kelley Hensley, representative of an industry at large Jim Sexton and contingent upon the Health Department position being filled. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Bivens made a motion to approve an appropriation, not to exceed \$3,500, for the repair of a broken HVAC unit at the Morristown-Hamblen Library. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to approve a change in the Parks & Recreation budgeted project from Wayne Hansard Playground Project to Wayne Hansard Playground & Shelter Project. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to approve the hiring of Matt Webb as an entry-level Police Officer. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to approve the hiring of Matthew Johnson as an entry-level Police Officer. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the hiring of Joshua Price as an entry-level Police Officer. Councilmember Bivens seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Senter made a motion to approve the hiring of Jocelyn Rajkowski as an entry-level Police Officer. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

#### City Council convened as Beer Board.

The following are compliance violations against the off-premise establishments listed for underage sale of beer, Municipal Code, 8-213-4.

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to impose a thirty (30) day suspension of license to sell beer or an in-lieu of suspension civil penalty of \$1,000 to Westside Market, 303 Jarnigan Ave. Councilmember Chesney seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to impose a sixty (60) day suspension of license to sell beer or an in-lieu of suspension civil penalty of \$1,500 (2<sup>nd</sup> offense) to By-Lo Market #6, 710 Morelock Road. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call: Councilmembers Garrett, Bivens, Alvis, LeBel, Chesney and Mayor Thomas voted "aye"; Councilmember Senter voted "no".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to impose a thirty (30) day suspension of license to sell beer or an in-lieu of suspension civil penalty of \$1,000 to Ingle's Grocery #85, 3980 West A.J. Hwy. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to impose a thirty (30) day suspension of license to sell beer or an in-lieu of suspension civil penalty of \$1,000 to Ingle's Grocery #313, 2342 East A.J. Hwy. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Alvis made a motion to impose a thirty (30) day suspension of license to sell beer or an in-lieu of suspension civil penalty of \$1,000 to Fastop #7, 5056 West A.J. Hwy. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to impose a thirty (30) day suspension of license to sell beer or an in-lieu of suspension civil penalty of \$1,000 to Fastop #9, 2900 West A.J. Hwy. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember LeBel made a motion to impose a thirty (30) day suspension of license to sell beer or an in-lieu of suspension civil penalty of \$1,000 to Food City #607, 2181 West A.J. Hwy. Councilmember Alvis seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".

Councilmember Chesney made a motion to impose a thirty (30) day suspension of license to sell beer or an in-lieu of suspension civil penalty of \$1,000 to Stop-N-Go Smoke Shop, 3486 West A.J. Hwy. Councilmember LeBel seconded the motion and upon roll call; all voted "aye".


