Funding is expected to be available on October 1, 2024, and at this time the approximate funding anticipated will be \$6.5 million for all listed programs. Funding amounts should be considered approximate.

- CDBG Development: \$2.7 million
- CDBG Public Services: \$630,000
- CDBG-CV: - \$500,000
- ESG: \$247,442 (Emergency Shelter Cap \$148,000)
- NSP: \$515,000
