



PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE
ADOPTION PROPOSED UPDATE TO THE PASCO MPO'S
LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY PLAN (LEP)

The Pasco County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), the designated agency responsible for conducting a countywide transportation planning program, will hold a public MPO Board meeting on August 8, 2024 to seek approval to consider and adopt the Pasco County MPO's 2024 Update to its Limited English Proficiency Plan (LEP). The Pasco MPO adopted an LEP in 2017. This updated 2024 LEP reflects any changes in countywide demographics as provided by the most recent 2020 U.S. Census and American Community Survey. The MPO's dedication to its public participation goal and objectives to provide outreach for all interested residents for its Plans, Programs and special studies remains the same. The 2024 LEP Update was coordinated with the MPO's current efforts such as the Update to the 2024 Public Participation Plan and the development of the 2050 Innovate Pasco Long Range Transportation Plan. The meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. at the Historic Pasco County Courthouse Board Room, Second Floor, 37918 Meridian Avenue, Dade City, FL 33525.

Once adopted on August 8, 2024, the 2024 Major Update to the PPP will be available on the MPO's website [Public Notices \(pascocountyfl.net\)](http://pascocountyfl.net). The MPO invites public comment on all Plans and Programs on a continuous basis, and comments can be submitted through the MPO email: mpocomments@pascocountyfl.net; call the MPO directly at 727. 847.8140, TTY: 800.955.8771; or submit an MPO Public Comment Form available on the MPO's website by 5:00 p.m. prior to MPO meeting to be addressed during the public comment period.
