ORDINANCE NO. 23-02

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PASCO COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING CHAPTER 67-1889, LAWS OF FLORIDA AND SECTION 218-1 OF THE PASCO COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES; REGULATING FEES FOR HEALTH DEPARTMENT DOCUMENTS AND SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR RATIFICATION OF PAST ACTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

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**WHEREAS**, during the 1967 legislative session the legislature adopted a local bill, Chapter 67-1889, Laws of Florida, relating to the procedures for the establishment of fee schedules for public health services rendered through the county health departments which became Section 218-1 of the Pasco County Code of Ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 218-1 of the Pasco County Code of Ordinances is entitled Fees for health department documents and services; and

**WHEREAS**, subsequently Section 154.06, Florida Statutes, was adopted in the 1969 legislative session providing for the establishment of fee schedules for public health services rendered through the county health departments; and

**WHEREAS**, Article VIII, Section 6 to the Florida Constitution provides that local laws relating to unincorporated areas of a county on the effective date of such article may be amended or repealed by county ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, with the implementation of Section 154.06, Section 218-1 of the Pasco County Code of Ordinances is no longer necessary for the implementation of fee schedules for public health services rendered by the Department of Health in Pasco County; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners that Section 218-1 should be repealed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Pasco County, Florida, that:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 67-1889, Laws of Florida and Section 218-1 of the Pasco County Code of Ordinances, are hereby repealed and rescinded.

**SECTION 2.** Any actions taken not strictly in accord with the terms of Chapter 67-1889, Laws of Florida and Section 218-1 of the Pasco County Code of Ordinances are hereby ratified and confirmed.

**SECTION 3. Recitals.** The foregoing WHEREAS clauses are hereby adopted as

legislative findings of the Board of County Commissioners and are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 4. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof of the County in conflict with the provisions herein contained are hereby superseded and repealed, only to the extent of such conflict.




