EVACUATION ORDER -- Hurricane Milton

WHEREAS, significant local heavy rainfall and flash flooding, wind, storm surge, coastal flooding and erosion have occurred in Pasco County as a result of Hurricane Milton moving into and through the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, riverine flooding from Hurricane Milton represents an ongoing threat to the lives and property of residents and businesses in Pasco County and elsewhere in the state.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Governor's Executive Order 24-214, as modified by Governor's Executive Order 24-215, Pasco County Board of County Commissioners' Resolution No. 25-006, Chapter 252 of the Florida Statutes, Governor's Executive Order 80-29, Pasco County's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, and Chapter 30, Article II, of the Pasco County Code of Ordinances, and under the direct authority of the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners, the undersigned on behalf of the Board and based on the information known or projected at this time, makes the following evacuation order in accordance with the Pasco County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan.

Pursuant to the authority recited above, the undersigned does hereby <u>recommend</u> <u>voluntary evacuations</u> of the following persons/locations described below:

- Areas subject to riverine flooding labeled "voluntary evacuation" on attached map
 Exhibit 1
 - Elfers
 - Cypress Creek at Worthington Gardens
 - Thousand Oaks
- Persons residing in any structure in coastal low-lying areas and inland areas that historically has experienced flooding in the past

Modifications to this order and maps identifying specific locations or areas for evacuation are identified by way of exhibit 1 attached to this Order. This Order and any supplemental exhibits will continue in effect until rescinded by an authorized person.

Shelters are open to the general public and their pets. Citizens should first attempt to find shelter with neighbors, relatives or friends. If that is not an option, citizens can self-evacuate directly to the shelter. Public shelter locations are located at:


The evacuation orders issued on October 6th and October 7th for <u>mandatory evacuation</u> <u>zones</u> are hereby <u>rescinded</u>.


