Did floodwater reach the electrical outlets in your home/business?

Pasco building inspectors have canvassed neighborhoods to assess damage. Be prepared for one of the following actions:

1. If inspectors deem it safe, power will be restored.
2. It might be safe to restore power; however, an inspector might have you disconnect certain equipment.
3. It might not be safe to restore power, so your meter will be marked for removal and will remain disconnected. If this happens, you should:

Hire a licensed electrician to certify your property is safe.

Once the safety check/repairs are complete, your electrician will provide an invoice and safety inspection affidavit to Pasco County, and the county will notify the power company to restore power.

4. Alternatively, an authorized property representative who is confident that their electrical system is safe to turn back on can complete an Informed Risk Waiver, which can be found on the back of this flyer.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

By signing this waiver, I, the undersigned, acknowledge and agree to the following:

I am requesting to have power restored at the residence referenced below. I am the property owner and/or resident and am authorized to make this request. I acknowledge that Pasco County recommends that I shut off the main breaker of the residence until a safety inspection can be conducted by a licensed electrician.

I acknowledge that if I choose to turn on the breaker without an inspection from a licensed electrician, I am doing so at my own risk. I recognize that turning on the breaker without an inspection from a licensed electrician contains inherent risk such as electrocution and/or fire. I voluntarily assume all such risks and agree to hold Pasco County harmless from all claims, demands, or liabilities arising from the power restoration process.

Further, I acknowledge that by having my power restored, I am in no way exempt from any permitting requirements for restoration of the residence. Further, I acknowledge that if the property is located in a flood zone, the property will be subject to the requirements of the Pasco County Land Development Code, Section 1104, governing Flood Damage Prevention. I understand that if the structure is determined to be substantially damaged, I may be required to elevate the structure.
