Fire Watch Information

The following information is in accordance with the Florida Fire Prevention Code, 6th edition.

NFPA 1:1.7.17.1 - The Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) shall have the authority to require standby fire personnel or an approved fire watch when potentially hazardous conditions or a reduction in a life safety feature exist due to the type of performance, display, exhibit, occupancy, contest or activity, an impairment to a fire protection feature, or the number of persons present.

NFPA 1:13.1.9 - When a fire protection system is out of service for more than 4 hours in a 24-hour period, the AHJ shall be permitted to require the building to be evacuated or an approved fire watch to be provided for all portions left unprotected by the fire protection system shutdown until the fire protection system has been returned to service.

Definitions

Fire Watch- NFPA 1:3.3.125 - The assignment of a person or persons to an area for the express purpose of notifying the fire department, the building occupants, or both of an emergency, preventing a fire from occurring; extinguishing small fires; or protecting the public from fire or life safety dangers.

Fire Watch Personnel- This shall be a dedicated person or persons whose sole responsibility is to look for fires within an established area. The assigned person(s) must have a way of communicating any fires or emergencies. This communication can be via cell phone, radio or any other communication means to transmit the emergency through the 911 emergency communications system.

*The Fire Watch shall be continuous until the fire protection system is repaired and then verified by a Pasco County Fire Rescue designee.
