

BIKES ON BUSES



GOPASCO's Bikes on Buses

program allows passengers to secure their bicycles onto a rack attached on the front of GOPASCO buses.

LOADING



SQUEEZE - Remember to remove all loose items from the bike. Squeeze the handle to release the lever.



LOWER - Lower the rack with one hand. The rack will lock in the down position.



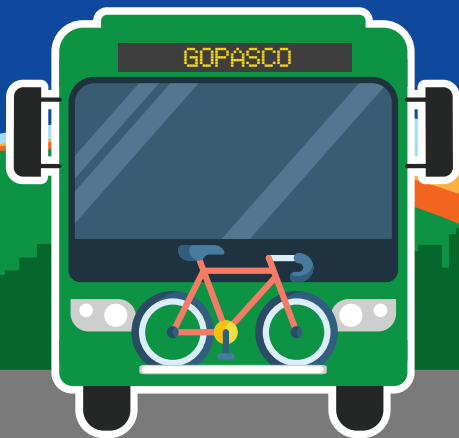
LOAD - Lift your bike into the available wheel well. Place your bike in the empty position nearest the bus. Please align the front and rear wheels with the labels.



SECURE - Lift the support arm up and over the front tire. The support should rest on top of the tire - not the fender or frame. Please note that a spring pulls the arm back and holds the bike securely in place.

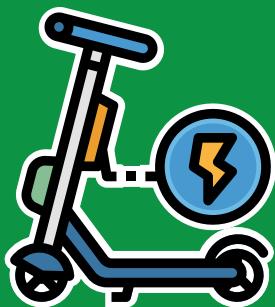

BATTERY POWERED DEVICES

- Passengers are permitted to place electric bicycles with sealed gel, lithium ion, or NiCad batteries in the bike rack as long as they have standard tires and fit safely in the bike rack.
- Passengers are permitted to transport electric scooters and boards with sealed gel, lithium ion, or NiCad batteries as long as they can be folded, and fit under your seat or on your lap.
