Picture/Photograph Rules

- Pictures/photographs that pictorially depicts sexual conduct as defined by Chapter 847 of the Florida Statutes are not permitted. This includes, but is not limited to, Acted or simulated sexual intercourse; Sexual bestiality; Sadism; Sexual Conduct; Sexual Excitement; Sexually Oriented Materials; Masturbation; Sadoomasochistic Abuse; Actual conduct with a person's unclothed genitalia, pubic area, buttocks, breasts; Any act or conduct which constitutes sexual battery or simulates the act of sexual battery; Nudity, defined as the exposure of the female breast including the nipples/areolas, genitalia, pubic areas and buttocks are not permitted.
- Individuals must be appropriately dressed, to include the covering of the genitalia areas, pubic areas, buttocks, and female nipples/areolas. Bikinis and male speedo bathing suits are permitted granted that genitalia areas, pubic areas, and female nipples/areolas are covered.
- Children must be appropriately dressed for their age. A child's genitalia and pubic areas must be covered.
- Decorations, symbols, mottos, or designs imprinted on or attached to the body, clothing, or accessories which contain profanity in any form, violent images, are considered vulgar, offensive to good taste or the maintenance of decorum, or which contain sexually suggestive words, phrases or images, advertise tobacco, alcohol, drugs, or which identify them as members of secret antisocial groups or gangs will not permitted.
- Pictures/photographs including any body parts must also include the individual's face in the photo. No pictures/photographs of solely body parts are permitted.
- No pictures/photographs depicting dismemberment of a human being or animal.
- No pictures/photographs showing the commission of a crime, as defined in Chapters 775-896 of the Florida Statutes.
- No display of a firearm or weapon, as defined Chapter 790 of the Florida Statutes.
- Gang signs or any hand signals that are not of a recognized sign language are not permitted.
- Filters are permitted unless they alter the face of the individual and affect the ability to clearly identify the person.
- Hats and hoodies may be worn as long as face can clearly be seen. No obstruction of the face to include, but not limited to, large sunglasses, scarves, masks, etc.
- No pictures/photographs of other inmates, mug shots, prison photos, criminal histories, criminal registration, booking photos or personal information that can present a threat to the security and order of the facility or to the safety of any person.
- No pictures/photographs of illegal substances and/or paraphernalia.
- No pictures/ photographs of identification cards, to include Driver's Licenses, state ID card, passports, or any other identifying information of an individual that can present a threat to the security and order of the facility or to the safety of any person.
- No pictures/photographs of screen shots of social media posts, photos, websites, text messages, snap shots or any other computer/phone application.
- No picture/photograph collages. Pictures/photographs must be sent individually.
- No Pictures/photographs that advocate racial, religious or national hatred.
- No text or writing on pictures/photographs. Messages must be sent separately as a message.

E-Messaging Rules

- Messages will be reviewed for any security threats and threats of self-harm or harm against another individual. This includes threats made by both the inmates and the corresponding individual.
- Any messages with a threat or safety concern will be reported to the shift commander for review
