On June 16, 2017, The County of Prince George, Virginia, PGEC Enterprises, LLC and The Industrial Development Authority of the County of Prince George, Virginia entered into a "Performance Agreement" for the construction, equipping, operation and installation of a "Fiber to the Home Broadband Project".

The Terms of the Performance Agreement require PGEC Enterprises, LLC to have installed and made available consistent and reliable broadband service to a minimum of five hundred (500) new subscriber structures after the date of the agreement, on or before July 1, 2021.

PGEC Enterprises, LLC is pleased to advise that as of the date of this letter, since June 16, 2017, the effective date of the agreement, there has been installed, consistent and reliable broadband service to five hundred and seventeen (517) new subscriber structures, fulfilling all requirements of Phase I of the agreement.
