



Service Center Metals to Invest \$101.7 Million in Prince George County, Creating 94 New Jobs

Service Center Metals, an existing Prince George County manufacturer of aluminum extrusions will invest \$101.7 million to expand its footprint in Prince George County. The company will construct an aluminum extrusion plant and compact remelt plant in Crosspointe Center to increase production capacity and meet customer demand. This new facility will mirror the existing Service Center Metals campus in SouthPoint Business Park.

Service Center Metals was founded in 2002 and started operations in 2003 in Prince George County, where the company has evolved into a top aluminum extrusion and billet company. Service Center Metals produces aluminum rods, bars, shapes, and tubing, all of which are shipped to metal service centers across the United States. The company is vertically integrated with two plants on its 30-acre campus in SouthPoint Business Park. Its flagship extrusion plant has two state-of-the-art presses and its compact remelt plant, the world's largest horizontal billet casting plant, recycles its scrap and produces aluminum logs for its extrusion presses.
