## RESUME

**RESOLUTION; AUTHORIZATION TO FINANCIALLY SUPPORT THE  
GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN NAMING A BRIDGE FOR DECEASED  
VIRGINIA STATE TROOPER NATHAN-MICHAEL W. SMITH**

State Trooper Nathan-Michael W. Smith was killed in the line of duty in Prince George County on September 21, 2015.

Trooper Smith served the Virginia State Police for one year and three months. He was a recruit in the 121st Trooper Recruit School that graduated in June of 2014 and was assigned to the Richmond Division, Area Seven upon his graduation.

On December 28, 2015, Virginia General Assembly Senate Bill 107 was introduced by patrons Senator Dance, Senator Cosgrove and Senator Ruff. A partner bill HB 184 was introduced by patrons Delegate Aird and Delegate Jones. On March 1, 2016, Governor Terence McAuliffe approved the following:

*The Route 301 bridge in Prince George County at Exit 45 over Interstate 95 is hereby designated the "Trooper Nathan-Michael W. Smith Memorial Bridge." The Department of Transportation shall place and maintain appropriate markers indicating the designation of this bridge. This designation shall not affect any other designation heretofore or hereafter applied to this bridge.*

The Prince George County Board of Supervisors wish to support the Virginia General Assembly in memorializing the life and sacrifice of Virginia State Trooper Nathan-Michael W. Smith.

Per the direction of the Virginia General Assembly and Governor, VDOT is willing to manufacture four (4) signs – two small and two large – which will properly mark the Exit 45 bridge (Route 301 – South Crater Road). The Prince George County Board of Supervisors would like to offer financial support up to \$2,000 for the manufacturing of the signs.
