### DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING PLUMBING ISSUES AT CENTRAL WELLNESS CENTER

As a result of the heavy snow on January 7, a plumbing problem has transpired at the Central Wellness Center. This has forced the water to be turned off until pipes can be repaired.

The difficulty is the pipes are lined with asbestos, and because it has gotten wet, it must be abated before the pipes can be handled. General Services Director, George Poulson, is in the process of getting estimates to remove the asbestos, which by its very nature is costly. Once the asbestos is abated, then repairs to the pipes can take place and the water usage restored.

Mr. Poulson will hopefully have the estimates for the January 24 Board of Supervisors' meeting. Any repair would be an unbudgeted expense, but an extremely high estimate will cause Staff to recommend the funds come from the Spring borrowing that will also be discussed at the January 24 meeting.

In the meantime, most Parks & Recreation activities have been moved to other locations. The plumbing issue should not affect the operation of the Food Bank or the Wrestling Club.
