MEMORANDUM

TO: Permit holders of New Construction and Erosion and Sediment Control Permits

RE: Inspection Policy for Active Construction Sites (Residential)

EFFECTIVE DATE: SEPTEMBER 1, 2023

The following inspection protocols will be implemented and uniformly enforced at the initial phase of construction for new structures and/or land disturbing activity.

- I. The (Land Disturbance/Agreement in Lieu Of) permit holder will be responsible for scheduling a site inspection at the initial installation of erosion control measures prior to the footing/excavation inspection request.
 1. Item(s) required to be in place at initial site inspection (and to remain until Occupancy Certification/project completion):
 - a. Address numbers (if applicable)/parcel identification posted at the road entrance (and on the lot/site if on a shared driveway).
 - b. Construction Entrance in compliance with approved erosion plan.
 - c. Silt fence installed according to approved erosion plan.
 - d. Construction Permit(s) and/or Environmental Permit (along with approved erosion plan) posted near the area of disturbance.
- II. If any of the above items are not in compliance at this initial inspection, a notification will be generated listing the deficiencies. This notification will serve as a one-time warning, and if the item(s) found to be in violation are not corrected at the next requested inspection, or at any point during the construction phase, a re-inspection fee of \$50.00 will automatically be administered and required to be paid in full before any future building construction inspection requests will be honored.
