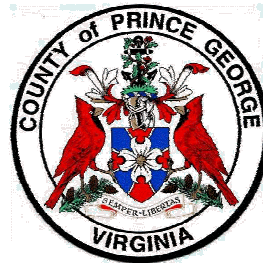

The Police Chaplain provides support for the Police Officer and the civilians in their times of need - this support can come in the form of assistance, advice, comfort, counsel and referrals.

## Services WE offer

- ◇ Confidential Faith-Based Counseling for all members of the Prince George Police Department and/or their family members.
- ◇ Assistance to police officers in the delivery of Death Notifications or other tragic news to members of the Prince George community.
- ◇ Provide assistance to the community members receiving the tragic news from officers of the Prince George Police Department.
- ◇ Assistance in resolving Domestic Disturbances.
- ◇ Training and instruction is a variety of subjects (i.e. Ethics, religious diversity, etc.)
