Opening:

Meeting was called to order at 1:14 pm EDT by Barbara Tabb, Chair. Chair Tabb confirmed the meeting notice was posted and published in accordance with Virginia Election Laws. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Secretary Young.

Public Comment:

No public participation and/or comments.

Director of Elections & General Registrar Allan Richeson update:

- November 7, 2023 election will have 4 different ballot styles.
- Early voting begins on Friday, September 22, 2023 with 10 different ballots. Voting will be from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.
- Prince George County, VA does not have any split districts this election.
- 779 Absentee Ballots were mailed on or before September 14, 2023. Deadline for mailing absentee ballots is September 22, 2023. 40 Ballots have been returned with 3 put in drop box.
- Saturday Voting will be on October 28, 2023 and November 4, 2023 from 9 am to 5 pm.
- Office Staff has been sworn in for Early Voting.
- Edison Research will be conducting exit polls at two polling locations.

Electoral Board:

ADA Compliance Certification: Motion was made by Chair Tabb and seconded by Vice-Chair Carden and passed unanimously that: Ten of the Eleven Polling locations including CAP meets the ADA requirements of Elect-310C-ADACC as explicitly identified in items 1, 2, & 3 on the ADA Compliance Confirmation form. Polling Location Rives 104, Central Wellness Center, located at 11023 Prince George Drive, Disputanta, Virginia does not meet all the ADA requirements. The Prince George County, Virginia Board of Supervisors have been contacted and notified of the ADA compliance concerns by the Registrar and Electoral Board.

Secretary Young motion and Vice-Chair Carden seconded that the Electoral Board authorize the Registrar Team to appoint Polling Place Officers of Election ensuring representation of each party where practicable and applicable. Appointments shall be made with continuity, experience, expertise, and knowledge of the rules, regulations, guidelines, and procedures. The motion passed.

Chair Tabb expressed her sincere Thanks and Thanked the Registrar’s office and Electoral Board for all the support during her personal matters. Chair Tabb indicated she was very appreciative of all of us; the team effort to keep the Voting process running smoothly in Prince George County, Virginia.
