

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER - 2023

JANUARY

- January 15: 4th Quarter State Estimated Taxes
- January 31: County Dog License

SEPTEMBER

- September 15: 3rd Quarter State Estimated Taxes

MAY

- May 1: State Income Taxes & State Estimated Taxes

DECEMBER

- December 5: Real Estate Tax (1st half of fiscal year & Stormwater Fee)

JUNE

- June 16: Personal Property Tax, Real Estate Tax (2nd half of fiscal year & Stormwater Fee)
- June 15: 2nd Quarter State Estimated Taxes

The due date for Personal Property Tax and Real Estate Taxes was pushed from June 5 to June 16 in 2023. Residents can expect a return to the June 5 due date in 2024.

IMPORTANT

TAX COLLECTION INFORMATION
FAILURE TO RECEIVE A BILL DOES NOT RELIEVE THE TAXPAYER OF ANY ADDITIONAL CHARGES THAT WILL ACCRUE UNDER THE LAW FOR FAILURE TO PAY WITHIN PRESCRIBED TIME.

TAX COLLECTION INFORMATION

- If a tax bill is not covered in an active bankruptcy, it must be paid in full by the indicated due date.
- An administrative fee of \$35.00 may be applied 30 Days from first notification of delinquency as outlined in section 58.1-3958 of the code of Virginia.
- If unpaid, additional collection action will be taken without further notification and will include one or more of the following:
 - DMV STOP
 - STATE SET-OFF DEBT PROGRAM
 - COLLECTION ATTORNEY REFERRAL
 - TAX LIEN
 - BUSINESS LICENSE DENIAL
 - NOTICE OF DISTRESS/SEIZURE WARRANT
- Once one of the collection actions above has been taken, all payments must be in the form of cash, cashier's check, money order, or credit/debit card. No personal or business checks will be accepted.
