Established in 1703, Prince George County's rich history encompasses the first days of Captain John Smith's exploration of the new world through the Civil War. SPORTS FACILITIES & FIELDS

JEJ Moore Athletic Complex

Prince George's largest athletic facility for sports tournaments is **JEJ Moore Athletic Complex**, which sits behind JEJ Moore Middle School. The Athletic Complex features four lighted softball/baseball fields, a multi-purpose field, a new playground, a concession area, as well as ample parking.

- Recreation grade, computerized field lights

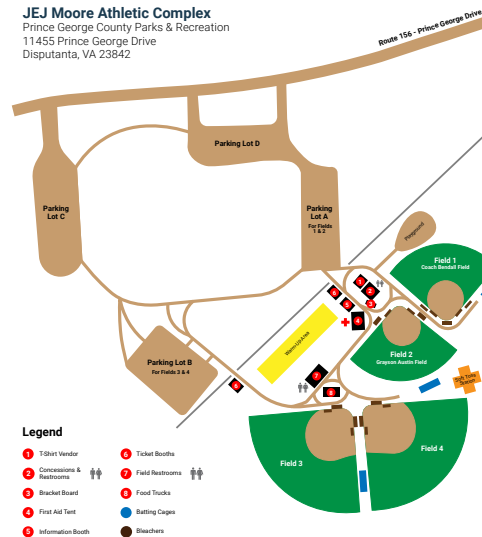


SOFTBALL & BASEBALL

For softball and baseball tournaments, players and fans arriving to the complex are met with ample parking before passing through the controlled access ticket booths. Inside, they will find multiple restrooms, concessions and vendors, as well as a first aid tent.

Each field has several bleachers and game watch areas for families and community members, and players can warm up at the batting cages or soft toss station.

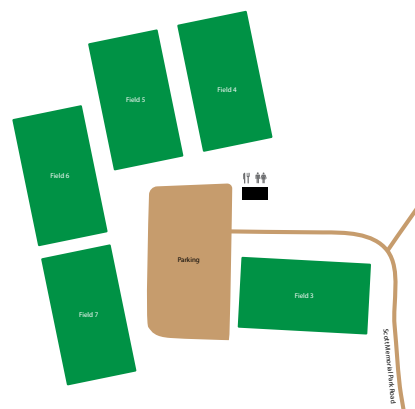

Scott Memorial Park

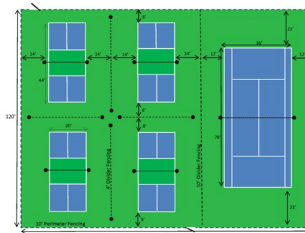
- 5 soccer fields that can be configured for any age group
