

Ordinance No. 2022-1A

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE CREATING RUBBISH
AND JUNK REGULATIONS**

Section 15 shall be deleted in its entirety and amended to read as follows:

Section 15: Penalty for Violations.


Any person who violates this Ordinance commits a civil infraction and shall be punished by a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the first offense, seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) for the second offense and one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for the third and subsequent offense(s). The penalty assessment procedures set out in § 16-2.3-101, C.R.S. may be followed in enforcing this Ordinance. In addition to the penalties prescribed above, persons convicted of a violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a surcharge of ten dollars (\$10.00) that shall be paid to the clerk of the court by the defendant as provided by § 30-15-402(2)(a), C.R.S.

The foregoing text is the authentic text of Ordinance No. 2022-1A. The first reading of said Ordinance took place on September 6, 2022 at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners. It was published in full in the Lamar Ledger on September 7, 2022. This Ordinance was adopted on second reading on September 27, 2022 at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners and shall take effect on September 27, 2022.
