November 7, 2023 Coordinated Election will be an all mail-in ballot delivery. Ballots will be mailed to all actively registered electors the week of October 16 - 20, 2023.

How do I return my ballot?

After receiving your ballot in the mail, you may vote and return it in the return envelope with the secrecy sleeve provided. Your signature **MUST** be signed on the back side of the return envelope to be counted.

Choose one of the following return options:

1. Drop your ballot off in the blue ballot box located inside the Prowers County Courthouse, 301 S. Main St., Lamar, CO first floor right at the security entrance check-in point or,
2. Place **adequate** postage on your ballot return envelope and mail it back through the Postal Service. **Remember** to allow enough time for mail delivery of your voted ballot or,
3. Drop your ballot in the ballot drop box located in the parking lot east of the County Courthouse building, drive up or walk up option that is open 24/7 and is under a security surveillance camera.

All ballots must be received by the County Clerk's Office no later than 7:00 p.m. on election night, 11-7-2023. Post mark dates do not count as received.

IMPORTANT DATES FOR 2023 COORDINATED ELECTION:

- **October 16 - 20, 2023: Ballots will be mailed to all Active eligible electors.**
- **October 30, 2023, Monday: Last day to submit an application to register to vote through the mail, a voter registration agency, a local driver's license examination facility, or online to receive a ballot in the mail for the Coordinated Election. (through the 8th day prior to the election)**
- **October 30, 2023, Monday - November 7, 2023, Tuesday: Voters can register to vote, obtain a replacement ballot or drop off their mail in ballots in person at the Prowers County Clerk's Office 301 S. Main St., Ste. 210, Lamar, CO 81052**
- **November 4, 2023, Saturday: Prowers County Clerk's Office, Election Department will be open from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. for ballot drop off, ballot replacements, or to register to vote.**
- **November 7, 2023: ELECTION DAY**
Prowers County Clerk's Office is open 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., 301 S. Main St., Ste. 210, Lamar, CO 81052
