Free Kill-A-Watt Meter Loan Program

Not sure if your appliances and other electronic devices are energy efficient? Now you can find out by going to your local Extension Office and getting a Kill-A-Watt meter on loan for a week. By using this meter you can measure the electricity use and cost of running various appliances. The meter is plugged in to an outlet and appliances are plugged into the meter. The meter then measures the appliance's electricity use and can project energy cost and use data over an hour, day, week, month, or year. Once meter users learn about how much a second refrigerator, a space heater, or a "phantom load" costs, for instance, they may decide to take action to improve their bottom line. After using the Kill-A-Watt meter, you may need to think about replacing those high energy use items with new energy efficient items.
