Everything you need to know & more...

DOG LICENSES: Dog licenses are available at the Finance Department on the 2nd floor of City Hall. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required.

CIVIC EVENTS: Through an application process to City Council, Civic Events can be approved to be held in the City limits of Howell. Applications are available online at www.cityofhowell.org. Privately sponsored events approved annually are listed on the calendar. Continue to watch the City Council agendas for when applications are submitted for upcoming events, dates, locations & times.

RENTAL REGISTRATION: The City of Howell Ordinance requires all residential rental property owners complete a onetime registration form, with an annual renewal. Forms are available online at www.cityofhowell.org.

RENTAL INSPECTIONS: If you are renting your residence in the City of Howell and have a concern or complaint, contact the City at 546-3861 so that we may inspect the property to make sure it meets ordinance standards.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE/ORDINANCE ENFORCEMENT: The City Code contains rules designed to protect your investment in your property including rules about outdoor storage of junk cars, recreational vehicles, trash and debris. If you feel uncomfortable talking to your neighbor about an issue like this or have been unable to resolve an issue, contact the City's Code Enforcement Officer at 517-546-3861. You will need to provide the address of the property in question and a description of the problem.

BUILDING PERMITS: Building permit applications are available on the 3rd floor of City Hall or online at www.cityofhowell.org. Contact 517-546-3861 with any questions. Please keep in mind that all work requires a building permit with the exception of the following:

- General maintenance
- Shingling over an existing roof (no more than two layers total)
- Exterior concrete/asphalt work on private property
- Replacement of existing cabinetry and flooring

WATER BILLS & WATER SERVICE PROBLEMS: Water bills are issued by and payable to the City of Howell on the 2nd floor of City Hall. Payments can be made in person, by mail, online, or through the drop box located in the vestibule at the Sibley Street entrance to City Hall. If you have questions about your water bill or need a final meter reading, contact 517-546-3500. For disruption in your water service, contact the DPW at 517-546-7510. To set-up online autopay for your water bill, contact 517-546-3500 or visit the website at www.cityofhowell.org.

SEWER BACK-UPS: If you experience a sewer back-up, you should immediately contact the DPW at 546-7510. For problems occurring after regular office hours, contact 911. Residents are encouraged to review their homeowners insurance policy and be aware of coverage levels for sewer back-ups. Under Michigan law, repairs and property losses for most sewer back-ups are the responsibility of the homeowner. If you experience a backup and believe that the City is liable, you must file a claim with the City within 45 days from the date the damage was discovered. To file a claim, contact the City at 517-546-3502. City of Howell field personnel responding to your home when you report a back-up are not permitted to authorize repairs, clean-up or replace damaged items.

NEIGHBORHOOD TREE PLANTING PROGRAM: The City of Howell has a spring tree planting program in which the City will pay 50% of the cost to purchase the tree and the homeowner pays the remaining 50%. The tree is planted between the sidewalk and the curb at no additional charge. Tree request forms can be obtained at the DPW, Finance Office or can be downloaded at www.cityofhowell.org. Once completed, mail to the DPW at 150 Marion St., Howell 48843. Questions can be directed to the DPW at 517-546-7510.

ANNUAL HYDRANT FLUSHING: All hydrants located within the City limits are flushed on an annual basis to perform required maintenance and to flush out any iron (rust) that has accumulated in the water mains. Flushing begins in May and takes approximately three (3) weeks to flush the 400 hydrants within the City limits. Some sections will be flushed during the night and the others during the day. Under both circumstances residents may see some rusty water. Residents should only experience rusty water during the flushing of hydrants in their area. If you experience rusty water, run cold water only 10-15 minutes to clear the rust out of the lines. DO NOT do laundry until the water clears up. Additionally, if residents notice a sustained decrease in water pressure, call the Department of Public Works at 517-546-7510.

RUBBISH REMOVAL: The City of Howell has a contract for weekly pick up. Those residing on the east side of Michigan Avenue, except East Grand River Ave, will be picked up each Monday. Residents on the west side of Michigan Avenue, East and West Grand River and the Rolling Oaks Subdivision will be picked up on Tuesday. Rubbish must be in garbage bags in the curb cart and placed at the curbside by 6 am on pick up day.

Cart Placement:

1. *Carts should be placed no more than three (3) feet from the curb.*
2. *There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your cart and any other objects such as parked cars.*
3. *Be sure to place garbage and recycling carts on opposite sides of the driveway.*
4. *Cart handle should be facing the house and away from the street.*

Extra curb carts are available for an annual cost directly from our service provider at 517-219-1163. Please re-view the City calendar for your pick up dates and holiday schedule changes.

BULKY ITEM DISPOSAL: If you have a large item to dispose of that will not fit in your curb cart, you may place it at the curb for pick up with your scheduled rubbish collection. Each week **ONE** bulky item is permitted free of charge to be placed at the curb for pick up.

NOTE: Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, etc. must have Freon removed with certification. Carpet must be cut into 4' rolls. Items that cannot be handled safely by two people will not be taken. Construction, dem-olition debris, large auto parts/tires will NOT be taken.

RECYCLING: Residents are encouraged to participate in the bi-weekly curbside recycling program. The City provides residents with a special 64-gallon cart free of charge. To sign up for the recycling program call our service provider at 517-219-1163. For information on how to recycle right visit www.wm.com/us/en/recycle-right.

TAKE THE FOLLOWING STEPS TO GET STARTED:

1. Prepare recyclables according to the instructions provided with the cart. Materials accepted include: newspapers, mixed office paper, corrugated cardboard, boxboard, telephone books, magazines, #1 through #7 plastic, aluminum, clear glass, and tin/steel food containers. Household batteries are no longer accepted.
2. Place recyclables in the cart and place at the curb by 6 a.m. on designated days. Refer to the calendar for pick up dates.
3. Recycling cart and garbage cart should be placed on the opposite sides of the driveway no more than three (3) ft from the curb.
4. Contact the DPW at 517-546-7510 if you have questions or need more information.

YARD WASTE PROGRAM: The Yard Waste Program begins in April. Waste Management will pick up yard waste (grass clippings and leaves) in paper yard waste bags or reusable containers no larger than 32 gallons. Reusable containers must be marked with a *Yard Waste Only* sticker available for pick up at the Department of Public Works, 150 Marion Street. Yard waste will be picked up with your regular trash collection through November (weather permitting). Collection dates are noted on the calendar.

BRUSH PICK UP: Residential brush pick up will begin April and end in October. Brush must be placed at curb no earlier than the Friday prior, and no later than 7am on the date of pick up. Brush for residences north of Grand River will be picked up on the 1st Monday of each month and continuing the rest of the week until completed. South of Grand River will be picked up on the 3rd Monday of each month and continuing the rest of the week until completed. Please call 517-546-7510 with any questions that you have. Due to the unavailability of a disposal site, stumps, roots and shrubs are no longer taken. Small twigs must be containerized to be picked up with the brush. Brush cannot be more than 4 inches in diameter and should be neatly piled with butt ends to the street. For residents who contract for private tree removal, it is the responsibility of the contractor to dispose of all brush. Brush pick up dates are noted on the calendar.

CLEAN WATER: Anything that enters a storm drain goes to a local lake or river. Storm drains carry runoff water from yards and streets to our local watershed area. Keep runoff water clean and protect our watershed area by following the Seven Simple Steps to Clean Water found on the City website at https://www.cityofhowell.org/city_departments/departments_public_works/clean_water_program.php. Help protect our local lakes and rivers by reporting any illegal dumping into catch basins; call the Department of Public Works at 517-546-7510.

HOWELL CITY BOAT LAUNCH: The City boat launch on Thompson Lake is located near the intersection of Lake Street and Roosevelt Street. The boat launch will be open for paid launching May 1 – October 31 and a seasonal or daily pass will be required during this time frame. Daily passes are available at the Bennett Recreation Center (925 W Grand River) during this time, or at the Howell City Park Main Park Guard Booth from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Please bring drivers license to verify residency. Launching of boats will take place from dawn to dusk. Violators will be ticketed if no valid seasonal or daily pass is visible in the windshield.

HOWELL CITY PARK: Relax and enjoy the natural beauty of Howell City Park. Whether you want to take a walk, play on the swings, picnic with family and friends, or enjoy the fun and sun in the water at the Beach at Howell City Park, there is something for everyone. Those wishing to enter Howell City Park between May 25 – September 7, will need either a seasonal park sticker available at the Bennett Recreation Center (925 W Grand River) or a daily pass. Please bring a driver's license to verify residency. Violators will be ticketed if no valid seasonal or daily pass is visible in the windshield.

STREET LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM 2021

RULES FOR COLLECTION

Residents are encouraged to bag their leaves for pick up with the normal Yard Waste Program.

The Yard Waste Program begins in April. Yard waste (grass clippings and leaves) may be placed at the curb for pick up in paper yard waste bags or reusable containers no larger than 32 gallons. Reusable containers must be marked with a *Yard Waste Only* sticker available for pick up at the Department of Public Works, 150 Marion Street. Yard waste will be picked up with your regular trash through November (weather permitting). Collection dates are noted on the calendar.

Bagged leaves (no plastic bags) are picked up with scheduled trash pick up

The Department of Public Works will pick up loose leaves in the fall under the following conditions:

Leaves must be raked into a furrow along the edge of the road; please do not rake leaves into the road. Leaves that are raked into the road may prevent storm water from draining and create potential traffic hazards.

Leaves should be in a furrow not wider than four feet to help make pick up more efficient.

Wet leaves to prevent blowing if needed.

The leaves cannot be mixed with any other materials, i.e. trash, brush or rocks.

If leaves are mixed with materials they will not be picked up.

Damage to leaf pick up machines from hidden objects may result in costly repairs to equipment.

Vehicles must not be parked along the curb or in the City right-of-way in areas where leaves are to be picked up. *If vehicles are parked in the way, leaves will not be picked up for that area.*

Plastic bags will not be picked up.

To prevent flooding do not rake leaves over storm sewer inlets.

The DPW will pick up leaves throughout the entire City, street by street.

Please help us by contacting the DPW, so it can be determined where the leaves are the heaviest. For additional information, please contact the DPW at 517-546-7510.

SPECIAL NOTE:

Residents on Michigan Ave., Grand River Ave., and Byron Rd. only: please keep leaves behind the curb.

By ordinance, open burning is not permitted in the City of Howell.

Please help us keep the children safe, by not allowing them to play in leaf piles on or near the street. Also please continue to educate all drivers in your household of the hidden dangers that may be hiding in leaf piles.
