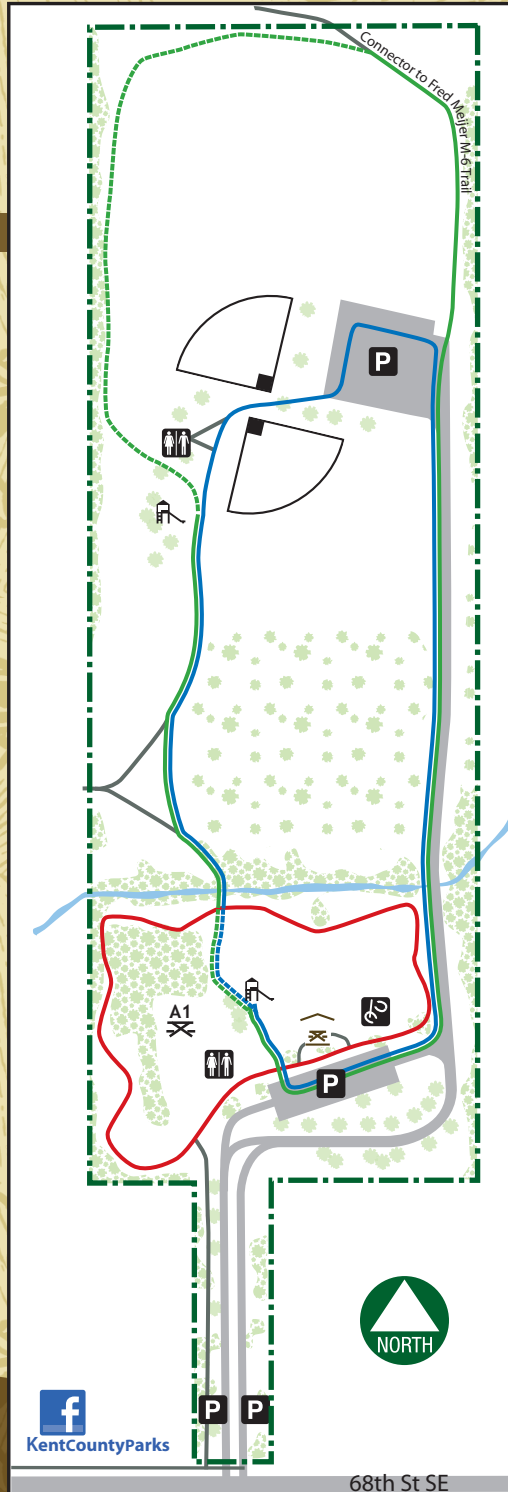


With 32 acres of fields and wooded areas, Creekside Park is an easy to reach oasis in suburban Dutton. The park features paved trails, playgrounds, ball diamonds, and an open shelter and picnic area that are ideal for group gatherings. At its north end, a 0.4 mile connecting trail links the park to the Fred Meijer M-6 Trail, which runs east and west through southern Kent County along the M-6 Highway corridor.

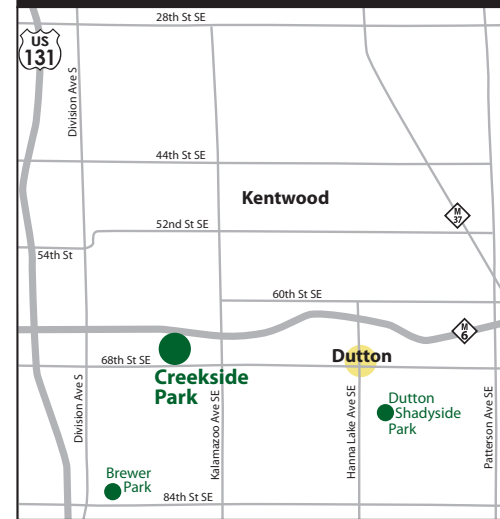
