City of New London Moves Polling Places

City of New London – City Clerk Jackie Beyer today announced changes in the City of New London polling places for the April 7 election due to the Coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic.

Due to the lack of adequate staff at all of the polling places, we are combining some polling places to serve the public. We apologize for the late change, but we are taking steps to notify everyone by use of social media and news outlets of the new locations.

These polling places have changed:

☐ District 1, Wards 9 & 10, normally at the UCC Congregational Church, has been moved to the American Legion, located at 840 E. W. North Water St, New London.

☐ District 2, Wards 6 & 7, normally at the Washington Center, has been moved to the Trinity Lutheran Church, located at 709 W. Beckert Road, New London.

☐ District 5, Municipal Building will remain the same.

Polling places will be open from 7 am until 8 pm on April 7, 2020.

Voters can also drop off completed absentee ballots at polling places or at the Municipal Building (City Hall) and are encouraged to use the Utility Payment drop box after hours or on the weekend. Please be sure to sign the voters' certification and have a witness sign and address, to avoid issues.

Dear City of New London Voter,

To ensure that your absentee ballot is received by the deadline to be counted of 8:00pm April 7, we ask you to please consider the following:

Hand deliver your completed absentee ballot in the completed certificate envelope to your City Clerk's office or to your polling place by 8:00 pm on April 7. (Preferred)

You may drop off your voted ballot and your completed certificate at the drop box located at the front of City Hall, labeled 'Utility Payments'. The last pick up from this drop box will be 5 pm on Election Day. If you are considering mailing your ballot back, please do so as soon as possible. The U.S. Postal Service advising that in some locations mail delivery can take between 2-7 days.
