***3/18/2020 UPDATE:** All facilities will be closed, including the Washington Center Gym

***3/17/2020 UPDATE:** *As Federal Guidelines are suggesting no more than 10 people gathering in place, we will be shutting down the Aquatic and Fitness Center as of Thursday, March 19, 2020.

All memberships will be extended and we will reevaluate all department programs, events and facilities on April 10, 2020.

As of 10:00 a.m. March 16, 2020, based on recommendations from the CDC and the Department of Public Health, the New London Parks and Recreation Department will be suspending, cancelling or postponing the following programs for the durations of their scheduled time. At any time these dates may be extended as recommended by the Department of Public Health.

- All adult and senior fitness classes will be cancelled for the current session. Participants will be contacted and will be given the choice of a monetary refund or a credit to their account.
- Senior Group Activities will be canceled, individual necessity programs such as the Tax Services and Valley VNA classes will continue as scheduled.
- The Senior Center will be closed; Senior Van Service will run for essential needs.
- There will be no facility rentals through April 19, 2020.
- Open Gym will be cancelled
- The Aquatic and Fitness Center will be open 6:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and Saturdays from 7:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. for their regular scheduled programming. The saunas will be closed.

- Swimming lessons for the current session will be cancelled and all participants will receive pro-rated refunds or credits to their accounts.
- Winter III Swim Lessons are cancelled and all enrollees will receive refunds or credits to their accounts.
- Walking at the Washington Center Gym will run as scheduled.
- All Adult Leagues will be postponed until further notice.
