Original Press Release from 05/13/2015

On Wednesday May 13th, 2015 at approximately 2:24 pm, Officers of the New London Police Department responded to a armed robbery at Jernegan's Health Mart Pharmacy located at 1301 S. Mill St, New London, Outagamie County.

Upon arrival the suspect was gone. It was reported that the suspected pointed a gun at the employees and demanded prescription pills and money. The subject got a small amount of prescription pills but did not get any money.

The subject is described as a male white, 40-50 years old, 6'00-6'02" tall, 190-200 pounds, with a big nose, and possible gray/black facial hair. He was wearing a black jacket with a hood.

The subject drove away in what is described as a 1995-2000 black Dodge Truck with a short box without a cap. The subject was last seen driving south on Division St from Douglas St. in New London.
