The New London Police and Fire Commission is a 5 member optional power commission which gives them added authority. This includes authority to:

1. Organize and exercise supervision over a police and fire department.
2. Adopt rules governing the internal control and management of a department.
3. Purchase equipment and supplies.
4. Audit bills, claims and expenses.

An “optional powers” police and fire commission assume the responsibilities normally exercised by the mayor in supervising the day-to-day management of the police or fire department. The police and fire chiefs report directly to the commission on all matters related to the management of their department.

The police and fire commission also takes part in hiring and firing of personnel, and is also involved in some discipline matters.

Appointment of Commissioners:

1. Is done by the mayor of the city.
2. The commissioner’s term is 5 years.
3. Residency in the City of New London is not a requirement to be on the police and fire commission.

Meetings:

The New London Police and Fire Commission meet on the 3rd Monday of the month at 6:00PM. The meeting usually last 1 to 2 hours.

Commissioners for the New London Police Department are not paid.
