

RESOLUTION R-2024-002

A RESOLUTION ORDERING AN ELECTION FOR A REFERENDUM TO CONTINUE THE SHAVANO PARK CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT AND ITS ONE-FOURTH OF ONE PERCENT SALES TAX FOR A PERIOD OF TEN (10) YEARS TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 4, 2024.

WHEREAS, the current authorization for the Shavano Park Crime Control and Prevention District, codified under Chapter 363 of the Texas Local Government Code will expire on September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 363 of the Texas Local Government Code provides for a process by which the Shavano Park Crime Control and Prevention District shall continue beyond its initial term, if an election is held and the majority of votes cast in a said election are in favor of the continuation of the District; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 363 further provides that the Board of Directors of the Shavano Park Crime Control and Prevention District may order said election or if a majority of the Shavano Park City Council adopts a resolution requesting a continuation, after notice and public hearing on the matter; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on January 22, 2024, the Shavano Park Crime Control and Prevention District Board, after notice thereof as required by law, held a public hearing on the questions of whether to continue the Shavano Park Crime Control and Prevention District, at which hearing all persons were given the opportunity to present evidence on the matter; and


WHEREAS, following said public hearing, the Shavano Park Crime Control and Prevention Board desires that the Shavano Park Crime Control and Prevention District and its one-fourth of one percent sales tax be continued for an additional ten (10) years, and that the Board of Directors of the District order a referendum election to be held in May 2024, on the continuation of the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF SHAVANO PARK, TEXAS THAT:

That the Shavano Park Crime Control and Prevention Board of Directors of the Shavano Park Crime Control and Prevention District orders a referendum election to be held on May 4, 2024 on the continuation of the District and its one-fourth of one percent sales tax for ten (10) years, at which election the qualified voters residing in the District shall have the opportunity to vote on the following proposition:

“Whether the Shavano Crime Control and Prevention District should be continued and the crime control and prevention district sales tax should be continued.”
