

RESOLUTION No. R-2022-009

A RESOLUTION AND ORDER CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE OFFICIAL RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION TO ELECT THREE ALDERMEN AND A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR ONE PROPOSITION.

There came to be considered the returns of an election held on May 7, 2022 for the purpose of electing three Aldermen and voting one special election proposition, and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made, that each of the candidates and the proposition in said election received the following votes:

The three candidates ran unopposed.

SPECIAL ELECTION

FOR PROPOSITION A

"The Reauthorization of the local sales and use tax in the City of Shavano Park at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to continue providing revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets. The Tax expires on the fourth anniversary of the date of this election unless the imposition of the tax is reauthorized."


SPECIAL ELECTION PROPOSITION A **[Passed]**
