Driving While Intoxicated – On Saturday morning, April 1st, at approximately 3:20 a.m., an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the 15900 block of NW Military for a vehicle exceeding the posted speed limit. During the traffic stop investigation, the driver displayed signs of intoxication and upon conclusion of field sobriety tests, the driver was taken into custody for suspicion of DWI. The driver failed to complete intoxilyzer testing, therefore the officer sought and received a warrant to obtain a blood sample for testing. The driver was transported to the Bexar County Central Magistrates Center where they were booked on the charge of DWI and released into their custody.

Theft – On Monday morning, April 5th, at approximately noon, an officer was dispatched to city hall for a walk-in theft report. The complainant indicated their elderly parent had previously been a resident at a location within Shavano Park. The complainant related during the time their parent resided at the location, personal property appeared to be missing. The complainant requested the incident be investigated and a report was generated. This case referred to criminal investigations.
