**Possession of Drug Paraphernalia** – On Sunday morning, April 9<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 1:00 a.m. an officer conducted a traffic stop in the 15400 block of NW Military for a traffic violation. As the officer made contact with the driver, the officer detected an odor of marijuana emitting from the vehicle. During the investigation two baggies of suspected marijuana along with drug paraphernalia were located inside the vehicle. The driver was cited for the offense and released.

**Driving While Intoxicated** – On Sunday morning, April 9<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 3:00 a.m., an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle in the 16400 block of NW Military for a vehicle exceeding the posted speed limit. During the traffic stop investigation, the driver displayed signs of intoxication and upon conclusion of field sobriety tests, the driver was taken into custody for suspicion of DWI. The driver failed to complete intoxilyzer testing, therefore the officer sought and received a warrant to obtain a blood sample for testing. The driver was transported to the Bexar County Central Magistrates Center where they were booked on the charge of DWI and released into their custody.

**Public Intoxication** – On Sunday evening, April 9<sup>th</sup> at approximately 11:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to a local business in the 4100 block of North Loop 1604 for a silent hold-up alarm. Upon arrival to the location, officers learned a homeless subject was inside the business causing a disturbance with other customers. During the course of the investigation, the subject displayed signs of intoxication and was placed into custody for public intoxication. The subject was transported downtown to a detox center where the subject was cited for the offense and released to personnel at the center.

**Minor in Possession of Tobacco** – On Tuesday morning, April 11<sup>th</sup> just after midnight, an officer conducted a traffic stop in the 4300 block of Lockhill-Selma Road for a traffic violation. During the traffic stop, the officer began impoundment procedures on the vehicle, when the officer observed the passenger in the car to be in possession of a tobacco product. Due to the age of the passenger prohibiting the possession of tobacco, the passenger was cited for the offense and released.

***Evading Arrest w/ Motor Vehicle*** – On Wednesday evening, April 12<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 8:30 p.m, an officer attempted to stop a motor vehicle in the 3700 block of DeZavala Road for a traffic violation. As the officer attempted to pull the vehicle over, the driver refused to stop and continued into the City of San Antonio. The pursuit was terminated and this case referred to criminal investigations.
