***Evading Arrest w/ Motor Vehicle*** – On Friday morning, April 28<sup>th</sup> at approximately 3:30 a.m., an officer observed a suspicious vehicle parked in the roadway in the 300 block of Box Oak. A passenger with the vehicle, was observed standing outside of the car, urinating. As the officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle, the passenger re-entered the vehicle, and the vehicle began to speed away. The officer began to pursue the vehicle down Lockhill-Selma, until conditions became too dangerous to continue and terminated the pursuit. The vehicle was later found abandoned near Blanco and Bitters and recovered by the San Antonio Police Department as a suspected stolen vehicle. This case referred to criminal investigations.

***Illegal Dumping*** – On Saturday evening, April 29<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 8:00 p.m., an officer patrolling in the area of the 4000 block of Pond Hill discovered several large privacy fence panels in the roadway. The items appeared to have been purposely dumped there by unknown individuals. This case referred to criminal investigations.
