***Driving While Intoxicated BAC >=0 .15*** – On Thursday evening, July 13<sup>th</sup> at approximately 11:30 p.m., a witness approached a patrol officer in the parking lot of a business in the 4000 blk of N Loop 1604 W. The witness related a driver in another vehicle had struck their car in the parking lot and as the pair exchanged information, the witness believed the other driver to be intoxicated. The officer observed the driver in question then begin to enter the roadway from the location and followed the vehicle for a short distance until the officer observed driving behavior consistent with an impaired driver. The officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and upon contact, the driver displayed signs of intoxication. The driver was taken into custody and transported to a local agency for Intoxilyzer testing. The results of the test, exceeded the state threshold of .08 for DWI. The driver was then transported to the Bexar County Detention Center where custody was transferred to staff personnel.

***Driving While Intoxicated BAC >=0 .15*** – On Saturday evening, July 15<sup>th</sup> at approximately 10:45 p.m., The officer conducting stationary radar enforcement in the 15400 blk of NW Military Highway, observed a vehicle traveling northbound with a defective taillight. The officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and upon contact, the driver displayed signs of intoxication. The driver was taken into custody and transported to a local agency for Intoxilyzer testing. The results of the test, exceeded the state threshold of .08 for DWI. The driver was then transported to the Bexar County Detention Center where custody was transferred to staff personnel.

***Theft*** – On Monday, July 17<sup>th</sup> at approximately 11:00 a.m., a complainant entered city hall and requested to speak with an officer in regards to a theft report. The complainant related they had Power of Attorney over their parent, who was a resident in a local nursing facility.
