**Theft** – On Saturday evening, July 28<sup>th</sup> at approximately 9:45 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a resident in the 100 block of Shavano Drive. The complainant related to the officer, they believed they had fallen victim to a telephone scam over a period of a couple months. This case referred to criminal investigations.

**Assault** – On Tuesday evening, August 1<sup>st</sup> at approximately 7:30 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a residential living facility in the 3000 block of N. Loop 1604 W. for an assault report. The reporting party related two parties were involved in an altercation where one subject pushed another to the floor, resulting in a minor injury to the second subject. **Theft** – On Wednesday afternoon, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, at approximately 5:00 p.m., a resident entered City Hall requesting to speak to an officer in regards to a possible identity theft case. The complainant related they noticed several new credit accounts had been opened utilizing their identifying information, for large purchases and wire transactions; all conducted without their knowledge or consent.
