Warrant Arrest – On Saturday evening, August 4th, at approximately 10:45 p.m., an officer observed a vehicle driving erratically in the 3800 Block of DeZavala. The officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and upon identifying the driver of the vehicle, it was discovered the driver possessed an active arrest warrant for ‘Driving While Intoxicated 2nd Offense’. The driver was taken into custody, transported to the Bexar County Detention Center, and booked on the active arrest warrant.

Recovered Stolen Vehicle – On Saturday morning, August 5th at approximately 3:30 a.m., an officer was patrolling the 100 Block of Broken Bough, when the officer observed an unoccupied vehicle parked in the middle of the roadway. Upon identifying the vehicle, it was determined the vehicle had been reported stolen by the Balcones Heights Police Department. The vehicle was impounded and the Balcones Heights Police Department was notified of the recovery.

Driving While Intoxicated – On Monday evening, August 7th at approximately 2:30 a.m., an officer conducted a traffic stop in the 3800 Block of DeZavala for a vehicle with defective taillights. Upon contact with the driver of the vehicle, the driver displayed signs of intoxication. The driver was detained and refused to provide a breath specimen. The officer applied for and was granted, a search warrant to seize a specimen of the driver’s blood for testing. The driver was then transported to the Bexar County Detention Center and booked for a criminal charge of DWI.
